



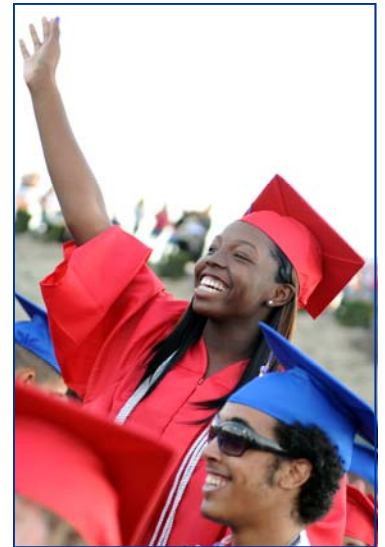
Developing Resiliency through Education, the Arts, and Mentoring

Fall 2009 Report to Our Partners

2008-2009 was an amazing year as DREAM expanded to serve all of the communities within the Twin Rivers Unified School District. DREAM began in October 2004 in North Sacramento with a private donation of \$10,000 to provide programs in the arts, field trips and athletics to students from high poverty schools in that district. Last year, we joined with the Rio Linda Education Foundation

and now help fund great programs in the 54 schools within our new district.

Last year, with the support of our superintendent Frank Porter, the Twin Rivers Board of Trustees, and our generous employees and business partners, we funded 60+ projects for over \$71,000 throughout the district. See the reverse side for a detailed list of this year's funded projects.



First Year Key Points/Accomplishments:

- Private, 501 c 3 non profit
- Gave \$71,000 for enrichment programs for 4,500 students
- 95% of all funds go to enrichment programs for students
- DREAM doesn't fund the full cost of projects
- DREAM funds enrichment programs not covered by state or federal funds
- Completely volunteer driven advisory board
- New website can receive donations online
- Provided backpacks filled with warm clothing, toys and school supplies to 430 students
- All money raised through annual Dare to DREAM fundraiser, business sponsorships and donations from employees
- Partnered with Bayside of South Sacramento to provide every student at Castori School with a new bike, helmet and lock for the holidays
- TRUSD Cabinet made personal donations to DREAM to support summer school arts and field trip programs
