Project DREAM (Developing Resiliency through Education, the Arts, and Mentoring) is a private non-profit 501(c)3 dedicated to providing programs in music, dance, drama, elementary and junior high athletics and field trips for students within the Twin Rivers Unified School District.

Project DREAM is a completely volunteer board of teachers, classified staff, business partners, and parents. **Ninety-five percent of all funds raised go directly back to our schools to fund projects created by site staff and none of the money is used to pay for programs funded through state or federal dollars.**

In our first three years in Twin Rivers, we've given **\$251,331** to TRUSD schools to help support enrichment programs for over 11,000 students. We've also given scholarships of over \$40,000 through our College Bound program. All of the money we're able to provide in mini-grants is donated by staff, business partners, and through our annual DREAM fundraiser.

We believe that if everyone gives a little, we can do a lot to provide programs in outdoor education, athletics, field trips, and exposure to the arts. We're asking that employees consider making a donation to DREAM through payroll deduction. If you are currently donating to DREAM through United Way, those deductions can continue if that is convenient for you. You will still get the benefits below.
